
Front Entrance Update

Architectural Guidelines



Article 7 Section 8 of the Covenants states: "All rubbish, trash and garbage shall be regularly removed from the Property, and shall not be allowed to accumulate thereon. All clotheslines, refuse containers, wood piles, storage areas and machinery and equipment shall be prohibited upon any Lot, unless obscured from view of adjoining Lots and streets by a fence or appropriate screen approved by the Architectural Committee. Nothing herein shall be deemed to apply to the storage on the Property by Declarant of building materials during, and for use in, the construction of

the improvements on the Properties." We are asking the community to help clean up the exterior of their property.

In an effort to help the community become more compliant with these regulations, the Board has decided to initiate a Community Clean Up Day. If you would like a screen for your property to hide your trash cans, you may submit a check to Amanda or Josh Curry for the amount of \$49.99 for the screen pictured above. These can remain white, or you can paint them whatever color you like, as long as it is in accordance with the ACC Guidelines. All screens need ACC approval. For those going with this screen,

we will have approval letters on hand at the date of instillation. We will purchase the screens in bulk, and install them for community members on the Clean Up Day. We will also be trimming trees at the Rec and Tot Lots, as well as any other areas that may need trimming. We are looking for volunteers to help with this, and will also sign off volunteer hours for any High Schoolers willing to participate. The Community Clean Up Day will be September 17th. All volunteers are to meet at the Rec Lot at 10am.

Solicitors, as long as they are not selling a product that they provide to the customer immediately, do not require any kid of license and/or permit to operate. Only a "Huckster", someone that does provide whatever they are selling right on sight, requires this. A "No Soliciting" sign on your own door would carry more weight, as they would be trespassing on your property. Hopefully this clears up any confusion.
